We look forward to your support as we all work together to "play it forward" in 2016!

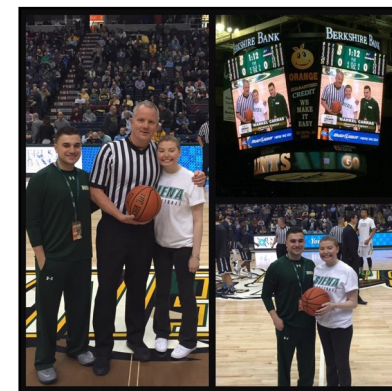
## Make-A-Wish NENY
